



World Environment Day 2026



GSFC University celebrated World Environment Day 2026 with a series of activities promoting environmental awareness and sustainability among students, faculty, and staff.

Organized by the University's Environment Club under the theme "Inspired by Nature. For Climate. For Our Future.", the celebration focused on encouraging collective action for a greener future.

A major highlight was a tree plantation drive at the Campus Arboretum under the national initiative "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam." Director I/C Administration & Campus Director Shri M.K Barot, senior management, faculty, staff, and students participated in planting native saplings, reinforcing their commitment to environmental conservation.

The event also included an Eco-Brick Making Competition, where students converted non-recyclable plastic waste into eco-bricks to promote responsible waste management. In addition, a Short Film Making Competition on environmental themes was announced to encourage students to creatively address issues like climate change, pollution, and biodiversity loss.
